Surbiton is a suburb of Kingston upon Thames. We visit the three large three manual organs in the main Anglican churches in Surbiton (Evangelical, Central, Anglo Catholic).

#### **1100 St Matthew's, St Matthew's Avenue (off Kingsdown Road) KT6 6JQ**

Organ by J J Binns, rebuilt Walker 1962. 3 manuals, 33 speaking stops: Great 8888442.2/3.2III8; Swell 16888842III884; Choir 888428; Pedal 3216168816. Last Club visit 1980.

**1230 Lunch** – members' own arrangements. There are plenty of places to eat near Surbiton Station and St Mark's Hill.

#### **1400 St Mark's, St Mark's Hill/Church Hill Road KT6 4LS**

Organ installed in 1960 by Mander after church was rebuilt after being gutted in the war. It contains much pipework from a house organ, and was enlarged, part straight/part extension. 3 manuals, 64 speaking stops, including small

West end section. Great 1688884442II III848; Swell 16888844III16884; Choir 1688884442.2/3.22 1.3/5. 1.1/3. III8888; Pedal 1616161688844IV1616884; West end section 88442. First ever Club visit.

### **1600 St Andrew's, St Andrew's Road/Maple Road KT6 4DT**

Organ by Hunter 1927 incorporating pipework from an earlier Bishop organ. Installed at St Andrew's in 1960 by Rest Cartwright (from Holy Trinity Church, Stroud Green). Electrified with tonal alterations by Dennis Coffin of Epsom 1977-9. Restoration in stages from 1989 to 2010 by B C Shepherd & Sons. 3 manuals, 47 speaking stops. Great 1688884442.2/3.2III84; Swell 8888442III16884; Choir 88442884; Pedal 321616161688844II168. Last Club visit 1990.

**Transport:** Surbiton Station is in Victoria Road KT6 4PE, which is in the centre of the town. Allow approx 10 minutes to walk to St Matthew's from the station, and the same to walk back to the centre for lunch and St Mark's. St Mark's and St Andrew's are near the town centre.
