Thank you for looking at this form. WE hope you will decide to join the Club!

Membership is open to organ enthusiasts of all ages, whether players, non-players, builders, engineers, teachers, researchers or lovers of organ sound. We ask that all young members (up to 16) are accompanied to our events by a responsible adult. (Our Safeguarding Policy can be found on the website.)

We have members from across the UK, and in mainland Europe, North America and Australasia. Our regular monthly meeting normally takes place on a Saturday. There are also short tours. Our popular overseas tours have taken Club members as far as Australia, the USA and South Africa. In September 2026 we plan to visit Spain. For younger members there are master-classes and a London Organ-playing Competition for teenage organists. Our younger members are automatically part of the Organ Club Student Organisation [OSCO]. The Club also has a Facebook page, our web site is www.organclub.org

The lavishly-illustrated *Organ Club Journal* is sent to all members three times a year. This contains reports, articles, reviews, photographs and membership news. Members on email also receive a regular newsletter, and those not on email are sent a version of the newsletter six times a year.

The Club keeps the cost of subscriptions as low as possible (the basic UK annual rate is just £30). Children under 18, and UK young adults (up to 30) in full-time education or apprenticeships, pay just £12. If you join after 1st September, the subscription runs until 31st December of the following year.
