Membership Issues

The RENEWAL DATE is 1st **working** day of January [UK 2025 - Friday 3rd January]. Renewal required to completed by 31st March, i.e. Month end after the AGM. It does not allow us to financially plan events if members dally with renewals.

YOUR existing membership number appears on the Journal and posted newsletters envelope, numbers starting 5xxx or 8xxx - no renewal needed.

The UK membership rate for 2025 is unchanged from the current year [Ordinary rate UK £30, Young members UK £12]. As we all know the postal rates are going up rapidly, so as many who are able to receive Newsletters by e-mail, please do so. For those living outside of the UK Royal Mail delivery area [Ordinary £40, Young £22], payment must be in GB pounds, international banking fees plus currency variations must be allowed for in your payment [in October 2024 $\ensuremath{\in} 53$ just about covers £40]. Under-payment due to exchange factors will not be accepted.

Joint members: Ordinary rate: 2nd or more adults, 50% discount per person. Young members: NO discount per member as the rate already subsidised by full rate payers.

If a member is able to enrol another member, then a one-off discount of £5 for the year's payment is permitted, but the person enrolled must be shown clearly on the renewal form - or in an e-mail to me for electronic payments. We are hoping that eventually as part of a major update to the website to be able to offer card payments, in the meantime members outside of the UK if they are unable to make £STG payments must contact me by e-mail. At a recent committee meeting it was agreed that the membership rates would be unchanged for 2025 & 2026 years, subject to unexpected and unforeseen circumstances**

To protect members, any member wishing to renew for two years may do so, simply double your payment - but please advise or show on the renewal form that will be part of the January 2025 Newsletter.


