

The London Organ Competition 2024

Rules and Conditions



The competition is administered by the Committee of the Organ Club. The Committee reserves the right to amend the rules as it deems necessary.

The decision of the Jury is final. No correspondence will be entered into. It is possible that prizes may not be awarded if an appropriate standard is not met.

Each competitor may enter one competition category only.

The fee per entrant for non-members is as follows which gives one year's young membership of The Organ Club [OCSO]

UK applicants £15

Applicants resident outside the UK £35

Organ Club OCSO members who joined the Club and whose membership payment for 2024 was received more than 3 months prior to the competition have free entry.

Any instructions given by the Committee must be strictly observed.

The competition will be open for the public to attend. The use of cameras, video cameras and sound recorders during the competition is prohibited.

Official photographs will be taken and may be used in future publicity about the competition and in The Organ Club thrice yearly *Journal*.

Page turners will be allowed to offer reasonable assistance with registration.

All competitors under the age of 17 must be accompanied by a parent or other responsible adult.

Entry to the competition confirms consent that personal details will be used by the Club as set out in the data privacy notice of May 2018.
