Thank you for looking at this form – we hope you would like to join us.

Membership is open to players and non-players of any age. We ask that all Young members at least up to 16 are accompanied by a responsible adult. We have a Safeguarding Officer, the policy document is on the web site Publications page.

The Organ Club was founded in 1926, the first President was Henry Willis. We have members from across the UK, in Europe, Scandinavia, North America & Australasia.

We meet usually on the third Saturday of most months, from time to time there is an evening visit in the South East region. Once a year there is a Masterclass. We normally operate an annual tour, this can either be in the UK or overseas. Between Christmas and New Year there is normally a Competition in central London for teenage organists.

The Club publishes a **Newsletter** six times a year, circulated by e-mail. By special arrangement a posted version is available for those without e-mail. This gives advance information about meetings and any Club notices. We also publish a **Journal**, A4 size three times a year with visit reports including photographs, reviews, general articles, etc. The Journal includes a Membership page where new members are welcomed. A sample copy can be sent to you. New Members are listed in the AGM Bulletin circulated to members with the March Newsletter. The Club also has a Facebook page, our web site is www.organclub.org

To encourage young players or young non-organists the Club has THE ORGAN CLUB STUDENT ORGANISATION [OCSO] where young members can meet together, their membership rate is subsidised by the Ordinary membership. They also have special meetings that are extra to the monthly meetings. OCSO is part of the Club and not a separate entity. Young defines all to the age of 18, and for those in full time study or apprenticeships, up to the age of 30 at 1st January. Once in normal employment over 18 the Ordinary rate applies.

The Organ Club's financial / membership year is the calendar year. If you join at /after 1st September your membership runs until 31st December of the next year.
